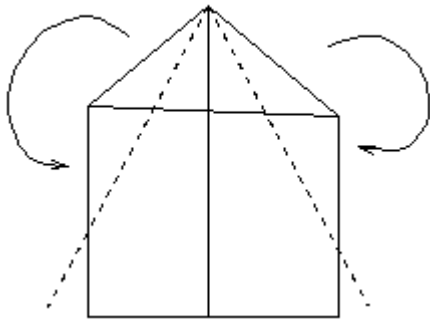
The Dart



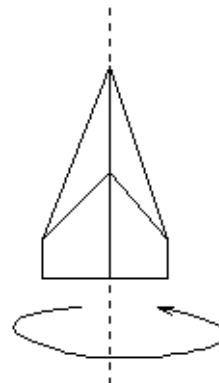
- Fold a piece of paper in half lengthways and open it out again.



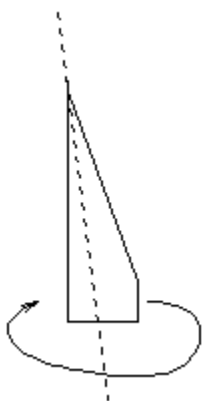
- Fold down the front two corners towards the inside of the plane - making the edge of the paper meet the fold.



- ◊ Now make two more folds into the centre.

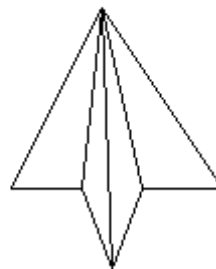


- ◊ Fold the plane in half along the fold made in step 4.

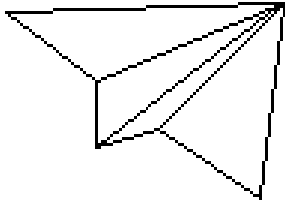


- ◐ Fold down the wings so they are the same size as the body.
Larger wings make the plane float better but smaller wings make it faster!

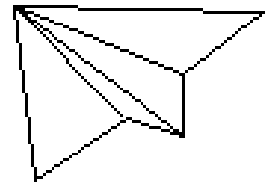
- ◑ Open out into plane shape.



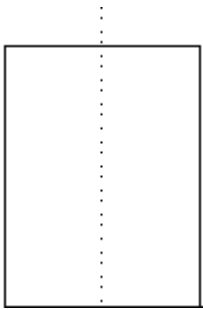

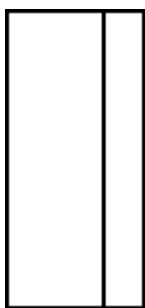
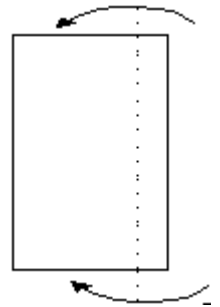


The Vortex



- Fold a piece of paper in half lengthways and open it out again. Cut or tear (carefully) along this line and give the other half to someone else.

- ◆ Using the half piece of paper you have left, fold over a 1cm strip from the side you have cut or torn.

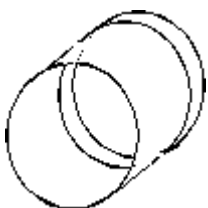


- ◆ Keep folding the fold over about 4 or 5 times until the total width of the strip is about 3-4cm.

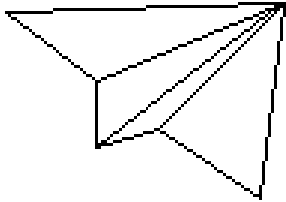
- ◆ Using a pencil to wrap it round, make the strip into a circle so the ends meet. Spend some time smoothing out the circle.



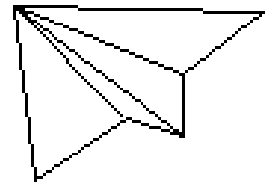
The smoother the circle is - the better it will fly!



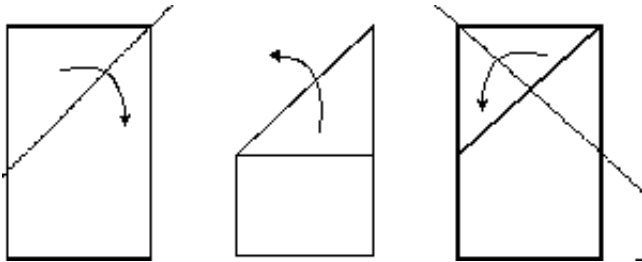
- Stick the ends together with sellotape, both on the inside and outside. The circle should be about 7-8 cm across.

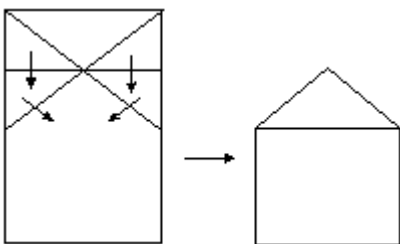
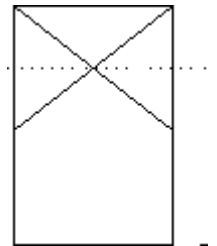


The Flatbed



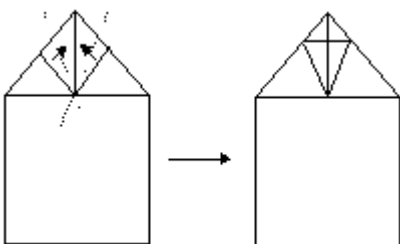
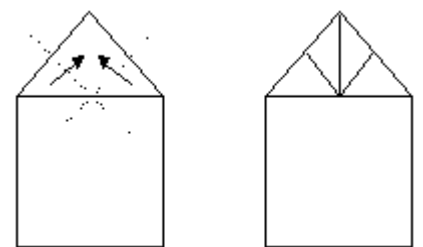
• Fold a piece of paper diagonally like this, then open it out and repeat on the other side to form a cross.

◆ Fold back widthways where the two folds from the previous step cross.



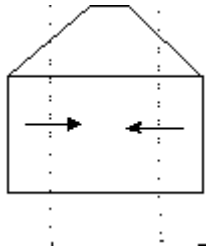
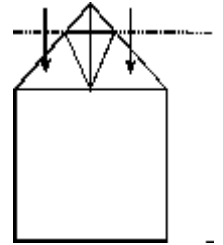
◆ Pull the fold made in the step above down and in, to form a triangle.

◆ Fold the left point of the triangle to meet the top of the triangle. Then do the same for the right to form a diamond on top of the triangle.



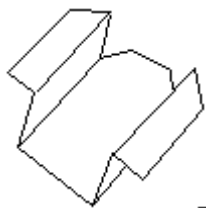
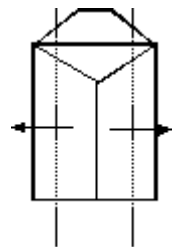
● Fold the bottom left side of the diamond into the middle and do the same with the right side.

► Fold down the small triangle left at the top of the folds made in the previous step, tucking the folds from the previous step into the triangle you are folding down. Then turn the paper over.



► Now fold over the wings into the centre.

► Then fold the wings back on themselves.



■ Opening up the plane, you should end up with this!
